Annual Report 2021/22

Happy 50th to London Cyrenians

In the news 50 years ago when Cyrenians was hatched there were wars and unrest, rampant inflation, strikes, disease, famine and foodbanks..... does this ring any bells with today's world?

This is a foodbank (right) set up by Cyrenians (then West London Cyrenians) in Kensington in 1978.

Cyrenians was forged against a backdrop of unrest and injustice, by a group of people who set out to make the world a better place for those most in need.

Our forefathers wanted to establish housing and support for people who had no place to call home. Volunteers

worked alongside street homeless to bring disused local authority buildings back into use. Staff, volunteers and service users shared houses with no "them and us" and a strong focus on what we share rather than our differences. For the first time in their lives people talked about "belonging" and having a "home" rather than dossing on the street, in a shelter or hostel.

We set out to foster belonging and establish homes from which to build hope and recovery. We have pioneered many service models over the years and have been recognised as part of NHS England's innovation pilots for our integrated clinical services. We established one of the first women only multi-disciplinary team services and have fed into national service delivery and development.

Despite the troubled times we are excited and optimistic that we can continue to listen and learn and provide services for those most in need. We are currently exploring ways in which research can better support our development and looking at funding opportunities that are not solely reliant on statutory grant e.g., Radical Rent.

A rough guesstimate tells me over 25,000 people have walked through our doors often unwell, unhappy and afraid seeking shelter, support and kindness. Later when they leave us for a new life, we trust it's with a heart full of hope and a smile.

I wish Cyrenians a very happy 50th anniversary knowing that we will use the lessons of the past, the values built into our corporate DNA and the desire to be good at what we do for the betterment of those it's our privilege to serve.



Chief Executive Report 2021/22



I am pleased to be introducing our annual report and calendar where we have asked people to share a favourite photo and memory.

Optimism may be in short supply but despite these challenging times Cyrenians has much to be proud of and to celebrate. As a prudent and responsible charity we continue to develop safely and within our means and are therefore able to face the obstacles above with 50 years' experience, financial stability and an innovative fundraising programme Radical Rent to maintain investment in quality and staffing.

Our phase 1 Radical Rent at Halford House was completed in Winter 2021 and was a triumph to planning, detail and forward thinking. The flats are designed with an original eye and modern twist for this Victorian house. The apartments were snapped up within a week by locals keen to see their rent go towards supporting people with mental health needs rather than into the pockets of developers. We have received planning permission for phase 2 of our Radical Rent programme and will be working in earnest to create 4 beautiful selfcontained flats in Islington from the tired and rundown property we inherited.

Given the staffing crisis in London we have chosen not to tender for new services as we are mindful of the problems caused by the sector-wide inability to recruit suitably skilled and able staff. This is a huge frustration for Cyrenians as we are proud of our cutting edge and successful model of service delivery and keen to expand this when safe to do so.

We are working closely in Hammersmith and Fulham to bring the large day service in SW6 back to its former glory so that it can be of value to local people from BAME Groups. The upgrade works are ongoing and we are optimistic that it can be brought into safe community use soon.

Chief Executive Report 2021/22

This year we have continued to upgrade our existing properties to ensure that service users have modern, clean and pleasant environments in which to begin their recovery journeys. This includes being mindful of our Environment and Sustainability plans and replacing old inefficient systems with newer greener ones where possible.

As the sector continues to face unprecedented shortages, we have looked at creative and responsible ways to recruit and retain staff. We have a well-received discretionary recognition award, comprehensive training programme and have just completed a review of terms and conditions. We are working with several universities to support young talent coming through and to promote adult social care as a vibrant and rewarding career.

We have been reviewing our service models and looking at ways we can introduce more clinical support from psychologists and nurses. We have begun our health outcomes review with service users and look forward to completing this and implementing findings before the end of the financial year. We are thrilled to introduce 2 young trainee trustees to our fold this year. They have helped us to promote work streams that include:

- Recruiting younger people
- Age-appropriate activities programmes
- Service user feedback sessions
- Establishing a young person's panel

We are mindful from feedback from our young trainee trustees and service users that our corporate image can look a bit staid and dated. We have therefore begun the process of reviewing our identity with the view to beginning the re-branding process.

I am also proud to be at the helm of this incredible organisation with its wonderful history, staff and service users in this our half century.






